## COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1968

*Recreational Byelaws—Water Parks*

Notice is given that the Anglian Water Authority intend after the expiration of one month from the publication of this notice to apply to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation of Byelaws made under section 22 of the Countryside Act 1968 and section 36 of the Water Act 1973 relating to the Authority's reservoirs and other waters and waterways owned and managed by them and the land held therewith providing for the preservation of order and the prevention of damage and for securing that persons resorting thereto will so behave themselves as to avoid undue interference with the enjoyment of the same by other persons.
