## BLACKBURN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Blackburn (Back Duckworth Street, Darwen) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980*

*The Borough of Blackburn (Back Duckworth Street, Darwen) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 20th May 1980 the Blackburn Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council made the above Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be (a) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the streets set out in the First Schedule hereto and (b) to prohibit the driving of vehicles in the length of road specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

These Orders, which will come into operation on 1st July 1980, together with the appropriate maps, may be examined at my office and at the Municipal Buildings, Darwen, during normal office hours and may be challenged in the High Court within 6 weeks from the date on which they were made.
