The Leicester (Box Junctions) (West Bridge Area) (No. 11) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that Leicester City Council as Agents authorised by Leicestershire County Council have made the following Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, to come into operation on 30th June 1980.

The effect of this Order is to provide "Yellow Box" road markings at the road junctions listed which prohibits vehicles waiting within those areas except in the case of vehicles waiting to make a right turn.

- (i) King Richard's Road/Kate Street.
- (ii) St. Augustine Road/Narborough Road North.
- (iii) St. Augustine Road/Tudor Road.
- (iv) St. Augustine Road/Bus only road.
- (v) St. Augustine Road/Richard III Road.
- (vi) Hinckley Road/Andrewes Street.
- (vii) Narborough Road/Hinckley Road.

A copy of the Order, a copy of the relevant map and the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order may be seen at the City Attorney's Office, New Walk Centre, Welford Place, Leicester, at all reasonable hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 16th May 1980 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Lincolnshire County Council (Gladstone Terrace, Grantham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Lincolnshire County Council has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to retain the restrictions mentioned below which were revoked by the Lincolnshire County Council (Various Roads Grantham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1980.

Gladstone Terrace, Grantham, no waiting at any time on the east side between points 15 metres and 45.7 metres north of its junction with Brook Street.

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lincolnshire County Council (Various Roads, Grantham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that the Lincolnshire County Council has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974. The effect of the Order will be to impose the following restrictions on the under-mentioned lengths of road in Grantham.

C

No waiting at any time

Brook Street, north side, from 64 metres west of the west boundary of Brownlow Street westwards to North Street.

Brook Street, south side, from west boundary of Swinegate westwards for 16 metres, and from junction with Watergate eastwards for 4.3 metres.

North Street, east side, from the southern boundary of its junction with Broad Street southwards for 21 metres and from 44 metres south of the southern boundary of Broad Street to junction with Brook Street.

London Road, west side, between points 19.4 metres and 31.4 metres, points 55.4 metres and 63.4 metres, points 106 metres and 119.4 metres north of the northern boundary of the southern junction of Rycroft Street.

Watergate, east side, from its junction with Brook Street south westwards for 32.1 metres.

Waiting Limited to 30 minutes between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.—Return Prohibited within 30 minutes

Brook Street, north side, from 28 metres west of the west boundary of Brownlow Street westwards for 22 metres.

North Street, east side, between points 21 metres and 44 metres south of the southern boundary of Broad Street.

London Road, east side, from the southern boundary of No. 9 London Road northwards for 6 metres.

London Road, west side, between points 8.4 metres and 19.4 metres, points 31.4 metres and 55.4 metres, points 63.4 metres and 106.4 metres, and points 119.4 metres and 124.4 metres north of the northern boundary of the southern junction of Rycroft Street.

Revoke Existing Waiting Restrictions

George Street, on the north side, from 18.3 metres east of its junction with Castlegate eastwards for 15.5 metres.

George Street, on the south side, from a point 28.8 metres east of its junction with Castlegate eastwards for 5 metres.

Gladstone Terrace, on the east side, between points 15 metres and 45.7 metres north of the junction with Brook Street.

Lincolnshire County Council (Gospelgate, George Street and Schoolhouse Lane, Louth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that the Lincolnshire County Council has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive in the undermentioned lengths of road in Louth.

1. *Gospelgate, north side, from the east side of its junction with George Street westwards for 18 metres and from 18 metres west of that point westwards to the junction with Schoolhouse Lane.*

2. *Gospelgate, north side, from the west side of Schoolhouse Lane westwards for 5 metres and from 20 metres west of that point westwards to the junction with Breakieck Lane.*

3. *George Street, both sides, from its junction with Gospelgate southwards for 30 metres.*

4. *Schoolhouse Lane, both sides, from its junction with Gospelgate northwards for 27 metres.*
