- (c) between a point 19.81 metres west of the western kerb-line of Curtain Road and that kerb-line.

 - (i) between a point 13.72 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Hoxton Street and a point 28.96 metres west of the western kerb-line of Hoxton Street;

 - (b) the south side, between the south-eastern kerb-line of Curtain Road and a point 35.66 metres east of that kerb-line.

- (b) between the eastern kerb-line of Charlotte Road and a point 19.81 metres west of the western kerb-line of Curtain Road.
