

BURY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Kersal Vale Road, Prestwich) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Borough) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury pursuant to arrangements made with the County Council of Greater Manchester under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, have made an Order under sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is:

- (a) To prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the westerly side of Kersal Vale Road, Prestwich from the Bury/Salford boundary for a distance of 120 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- (b) To prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the easterly side of Kersal Vale Road, Prestwich from the Bury/Salford boundary for a distance of 50 metres in a north-westerly direction.

The Order will contain exceptions to permit waiting for boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, the removal of furniture, funerals, building operations or work on or under the length of road. Disabled persons vehicles bearing a disabled person's badge and a parking disc will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within one hour.

A copy of the Order which comes into effect on 23rd June 1980 and a map showing the road to which it relates may be examined at the Department of Administration, Town Hall, Bury, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that the requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 18th June 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

CHELMSFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Chelmsford (Victoria Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 13th June 1980, Chelmsford Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Essex County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the layby adjacent to the Post Office Sorting Office in Victoria Road, Chelmsford, between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 7 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays.

There will be exemptions for people boarding or alighting from vehicles and for statutory undertakers and for loading and unloading goods to or from vehicles.

The Order will come into effect on 27th June 1980 or as soon thereafter as the signs are erected.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of road affected may be inspected at the Secretary's Department, Civic Centre, Chelmsford, Essex between 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. on weekdays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

CHELMSFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Chelmsford (Molrams Lane, Great Baddow) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 13th June 1980, Chelmsford Borough Council acting as duly authorised agents of the Highway Authority made an Order under section 74(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and all other enabling powers.

When this Order comes into effect, no person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of Molrams Lane, Great Baddow, from a point 90 metres north of its junction with Ladywell Lane for a distance measured in a northerly direction of 350 metres.
