1. *The Warwickshire County Council (Wilmcote, Aston Cantlow) Public Path Creation Order 1978*
2. *The Warwickshire County Council (Footpath AL.78d Aston Cantlow) Public Path Extinguishment Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that on 30th June 1980 the Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above-named Creation Order and on 7th July 1980 confirmed the above-named Extinguishment Order, both as unopposed Orders. The effect of the Orders, as confirmed, is as follows:

- (1) Create a public footpath from a point on footpath AL.78a 149 metres south of the junction between footpath AL.78a and the Aston Cantlow-Wilmcote Road, eastwards between numbers 25 and 27 Swanfold, Wilmcote for 39 metres to the eastern side of Swanfold, then turning to head generally southwards following the footway for 30 metres to join footpath AL.78d.
- (2) Extinguish that part of footpath AL.78d which runs from a point on footpath AL.78a 174 metres south of the junction between footpath AL.78a and the Aston Cantlow-Wilmcote road eastwards for 56 metres.

Copies of the Orders and the maps contained in them have been deposited at, and may be inspected free of charge at the office of the County Secretary, Shire Hall, Warwick, on Mondays to Fridays inclusive during normal office hours.

The Orders become operative from 14th July 1980 but if any person aggrieved by the Orders desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highway Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Orders he may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 of the Act within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application for the purpose to the High Court.

*North Yorkshire County Council, Sawmills Lane, Helmsley, Footpath Diversion Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 12th June 1980, the North Yorkshire County Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed is to divert the public footpath commencing at Sawmills Lane, Helmsley, near the north-west corner of O.S. field 140 (point A on

the deposited map) and running in a southerly then easterly direction alongside the eastern and northern bank of the River Rye to point B on the deposited map, a distance of approximately 440 metres.

The new path commences at point B on the northern bank of the River Rye and proceeds northwards to join the track which runs parallel to the former railway line, turns north-westerly to link with the road at the east of the sawmills to point C, a distance of approximately 160 metres.

A copy of the Order and map contained in it has been deposited at the Inquiry Office, North York Moors National Park Office, The Old Vicarage, Bondgate, Helmsley, and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative on 22nd August 1980 but if a person aggrieved by an Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that any requirements of the Act as amended or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may under paragraph 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 of the Act, within 6 weeks from 11th July 1980, make an application to the High Court for that purpose.

*North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 54 Helmsley Diversion Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 7th July 1980, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the North Yorkshire County Council.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modification will be to divert the Public Right of Way known as Footpath No. 54 Helmsley from the existing position which commences at Grid Reference SE 5859 8878 on Baxton's Lane High Baxton's Farm the path then enters O.S. Field 572 and runs in a westerly direction alongside the south side of the farm buildings for approximately 127.4 metres the footpath then turns sharp north for about 36 metres and then turns in a diagonally south-westerly direction across O.S. Field 572 for approximately 591.5 metres terminating at Grid Reference SE 5859 6877 to a new route which commences at Grid Reference SE 5859 6877 and will run in a southerly direction through O.S. Field 572 along the western boundary for approximately 227.5 metres it will then turn in a south-easterly direction along the southern boundary of that Field finishing at Grid Reference SE 5859 8876.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the North York Moors National Park Office, The Old Vicarage, Bondgate, Helmsley YO6 5BP, North Yorkshire, during office hours.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Chief Executive, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton DL7 8AD (quoting Ref. NYM.23/A/19 JA), before 11th August 1980 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the North Yorkshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
