## TREASURY SOLICITOR

#### VOV SECURITIES LIMITED (DISSOLVED)

Notice of Disclaimer under section 355 of the Companies Act 1948

Whereas:

(1) Pursuant to section 353 of the Companies Act 1948 Vov Securities Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") became dissolved on 11th December 1979.
(2) It is alleged that immediately before such dissolution the property disclaimed by this Notice was vested in the Company and may by virtue of section 354 of the Companies Act 1948 be deemed to have become bona vacantia and the bare verted in the Company and to have vested in the Crown. (3) It is desired to disclaim the Crown's Title (if any)

(4) That the property may have vested came to the notice of the Treasury Solicitor on 2nd June 1980.
Now therefore I, the Treasury Solicitor, in exercise of the power in that behalf given by section 355 of the Companies Act 1948 do by this Notice disclaim the Crown's title (if any) to the property described in the Schedule hereto.

#### THE SCHEDULE

#### **Property Disclaimed**

The leases of 308 and 310 Streatham High Road, London S.W.16 made respectively on 6th and 28th September 1883 between (1) Edward Hammond Thompson and (2) Henry Ellis Hill and William James Hill for terms of 99 years from 25th December 1882 at yearly rents of £30. Signed at London 16th July 1980.
