*The Winchester-Preston Trunk Road (A34)
(Whitway Diversion Side Roads) Order 19*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road and a new trunk road to be constructed by him at Whitway in the county of Hampshire, to make under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order which will—

- authorise him—
