Mee, Manor Farm, Ockendon, Upminster, Essex, for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of the stream running from Hall Farm Moat along Pea Lane by means of a removable weir at National Grid Reference TQ 581 842, Ockendon, Havering District, and to abstract 33,000,000 gallons of water per annum from the said inland water at or near that point.

The capacity of the offstream reservoir at overflow level will be 36,000,000 gallons.

BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Borough of Blackpool (Victoria Hospital)
(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd July 1980 the Blackpool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, made the above Order, the effect of which will be:

To prohibit any vehicle, other than an ambulance attending an emergency from using the ambulance exit road from Victoria Hospital immediately south of Whinpark Avenue and which joins the public highway on East Park Drive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (amended as aforesaid), or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
