Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11 (4) and 109 (6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, has now confirmed the Anglian Water Authority (Alteration of Boundaries of the Skegness District Internal Drainage District) Order 1980 (S.I. 1980/1048) made on 30th April 1980 to confirm the Scheme submitted to him under section 11 (1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, making provision for the alteration of the boundaries of the Skegness District Internal Drainage District.

By paragraphs 10, 11 and 12 of Schedule 3 to the Land Drainage Act 1976, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with he may, within 6 weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
