The Borough of Hartlepool (The Front, Seaton Carew, Hartlepool) (Restriction and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that Hartlepool Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and (84D) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972) propose to make an Order which will:

- (a) remove the existing "Waiting Limited to 20 minutes in any hour between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. during the May to September period" restriction on the west side of The Front from its junction with Church Street for a distance of 25 metres in a northerly direction and replace it with "No Waiting at any time".
- (b) remove the existing "No Waiting between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. during the May to September period" restriction on the east side of The Front from its junction with The Slipway for a distance of 65 metres in a northerly direction.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit the driving of any vehicle with an unladen weight in excess of 3 tons along that length of School Lane, Quedgeley referred to in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions in the Order will permit access for certain specified purposes to premises along the length of road affected.

Full details of these proposals are given in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Gloucestershire, and the Stroud District Council, High Street, Stroud during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the County Clerk, Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Gloucestershire by 15th September 1980.

SCHEDULE

- (c) prohibit waiting at any time on the east side of The Front from its junction with The Slipway for a distance of 25 metres in a northerly direction.
- (d) restrict waiting to a maximum of 20 minutes in any hour between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. during the May to September period on the east side of The Front from a point 25 metres north of its junction with The Slipway to a point 65 metres north of that junction, a length of 40 metres.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposal and a map showing the road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday at the Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool.

Objections to the proposals specifying the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the Borough Solicitor, Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool, by 5th September 1980.
