The Trunk Road (Ely, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended which shall come into operation on 7th November 1980. The effect of the Order is that:

- (1) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a south-westerly direction in that length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road known as Cowbridge Road West at Ely, Cardiff to make a right-hand turn into Crossways Road;
- (2) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a north-easterly direction in that length of the above mentioned trunk road known as Cowbridge Road West at Ely, Cardiff to make a right-hand turn into Caerau Lane.

The Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road (Improvement from RAC Box 487 to Storey Arms) Order 19
