ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Buckinghamshire County Council (Various Roads, Buckingham) (Experimental Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) (Extension) (No. 2) Order, 1980.

Notice is hereby given that the Buckinghamshire County Council (Various Roads Buckingham) (Experimental Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order, 1979 (hereinafter called "the Order") made by Buckinghamshire County Council on 21st December 1979, and which was extended for a period of six months on 13th June 1980, the effect of which Order is to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle proceeding in the roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice from entering the road specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Schedule, has been further continued in force and will so continue until 6th July 1981.

Exemptions to the Order will permit the following:

- (a) conveyance of goods and persons to adjoining property;
- (b) for the purposes of agriculture;
