The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865 (1865 c. 73) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) (No. 3) Order 1980.

General

- 2. The Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) (No. 2) Order 1980 shall have effect subject to the provisions contained in the Schedules to this Order.
- 3. Payment of basic pay and allowances shall be made
- in accordance with Schedule 1 to this Order.

 4. Flying Pay for Royal Marine Aircrew Observers shall be paid in accordance with Schedule 2 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

Method of payment

The method of payment to Royal Navy and Royal Marine personnel (i.e. payment in cash or by direct credit to the individual's personal bank account) shall be at the discretion of the Admiralty Board.

SCHEDULE 2

Royal Marine Aircrew Observers

With effect from 1st November 1975 Royal Marine Aircrew Observers Pay shall be payable to personnel who are selected for training and subsequently employed as qualified Royal Marine Aircrew Observers. (1 SI)

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the increase of certain pensions granted in respect of service in Her Majesty's Naval and Marine Forces to correspond, as nearly as may be, with the benefits provided, in the case of civil pensions, by the Social Security Pensions Act 1975 (1975 c.60), as amended by the Social Security Act 1979 (1979 c.18).

SCHEDULE

- 1. A pension to which this Schedule relates shall be:
- (a) Officers' service retired pay, service invaliding retired pay, service attributable retired pay, compassionate allowances, the service portion of disability retired pay, and a preserved pension.
- (b) Service retired pay, preserved pension, service invaliding retired pay, service attributable retired pay and the service portion of disability retired pay of officers of the Women's Royal Naval Service and of Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service and Nursing Service Reserve and of the Naval Nursing Auxiliary Section.
- (c) Men's and women's service pension, preserved pension, service invaliding pension and service attributable pension including elements for rank and age and additions for war service.
