EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

Parts of Footpaths Affected by the Construction of the Lodge Lake, Balancing Reservoir and Earthworks for City Road H5, Milton Keynes

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1965, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following footpaths shown by small black dots on the map hereinafter referred to:

- 1. That part of footpath No. 22 starting from a point on the map marked "a" approximately 150 metres northwest of Manor Farm, Loughton and continuing for a distance of aproximately 730 metres in a northerly direction to a point marked "b" on the map where it meets footpath No. 20.
- 2. That part of footpath No. 20 starting from a point on the map marked "c" aproximately 50 metres from its junction with the Loughton to Bradwell Road and continuing for a distance of approximately 1100 metres in a northerly direction to a point marked "d" on the map at its junction with the footpath created under the London Holyhead Trunk Road (Diversion Through Milton Keynes Side Roads) Order 1975.
- 3. That part of the footpath created under the London-Holyhead Trunk Road (Diversion Through Milton Keynes Side Roads) Order 1975 starting from a point on the map marked "d" and continuing in a northerly direction to a point marked "e" on the map at the underbridge taking the Brook and path under the A5(D) road and continuing further in a north-westerly direction to a point on the map marked "f", an overall distance of 340 metres.
- 4. That part of footpath No. 20 starting from a point on the map marked "f" at the boundary of the A5(D) road continuing for a distance of approximately 30 metres in a northerly direction to a point marked "g" on the map where it joins footpath No. 2 (Bradwell Abbey).
- 5. That part of footpath No. 2 (Bradwell Abbey) starting from a point marked "g" on the map continuing for a distance of approximately 490 metres in a northerly direction to a point marked "h" on the map at the bridge carrying the path and brook under the London to Birmingham railway line.
 - 6. That part of footpath No. 23 starting from a point on the map marked "i" at the junction with the A5 London Road (Watling Street) continuing for a distance of approximately 490 metres in an easterly direction to a point marked "j" on the map at the paths junction with footpath No. 24.

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished may be inspected at the offices of the Milton Keynes Development Corporation, Wavendon Tower, Wavendon; Cofferidge Close, Stony Stratford; and Lloyds Court, Silbury Boulevard; Milton Keynes, during normal office hours.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
