 (ii) the northern arm, between the eastern kerb-line of the western arm and its junction with the eastern arm, from west to east.
 - (iii) the southern arm, from east to west

(iv) the western arm, from south to north.

(f) Pinto Way

- (i) the eastern arm, from north to south.
 (ii) the northern arm, between the eastern kerb-line of the western arm and its junction with the eastern arm, from west to east.
 - (iii) the southern arm, from east to west, (iv) the western arm, from south to north.
- (g) Romero Square
 - (i) the eastern arm, from north to south.

 - (ii) the southern arm, from east to west.
 (iii) the western arm, from south to north.
- (h) Ryan Close
 - (i) the eastern arm, from north to south.
 - (ii) the southern arm, from east to west. (iii) the western arm, from south to north.
- 3. Exemption has been provided in the Order in respect
- of anything done: (a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.
