SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT 1975

The Thames Water Authority (Fixed Engines) Order 1981

Whereas the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has settled and made the Thames Water Authority (Fixed Engines) Order 1981 under the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act 1975 to enable the Authority, with the approval of the Minister, to erect and work fixed engines within its own area for taking or killing salmon and migratory trout for artificial propagation or scientific purposes or, except during the annual close seasons, for the purpose of sale.

Now notice is hereby given that such Order will be confirmed and will thereupon become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless a Memorial is presented to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food on or before 1th March 1981 by a local authority or other person or association affected by such Order praying that the Order shall be subject to special Parliamentary procedure.
