#### PASTORAL MEASURE 1968

Notice is hereby given that Her Majesty was pleased on the 18th February 1981 by Order in Council to confirm the following Schemes made by the Church Commissioners for:

1. Uniting the benefices of Egremont and Haile, in the diocese of Carlisle, and establishing a team ministry for the area of the new benefice.
2. Uniting the benefices of Reedham; and Cantley with Limpenhoe and Southwood, in the diocese of Norwich.

3. Re-arranging the benefices of Flordon with Hapton; Ashwellthorpe with Wreningham; Fundenhall; Tacolneston; and Bracon Ash with Hethel, in the diocese of Norwich and establishing a team ministry for the area of the new benefice of Wreningham.

4. Substituting the church of St. Boniface as the parish church of the parish of All Saints, Whipton, in the diocese of Exeter, and declaring redundant the existing parish church.

5. Declaring redundant the church of St. Nicholas, Ozleworth, in the diocese of Gloucester.

6. Creating the new benefice and parish of St. Andrew, Leam Lane, and altering the areas of the parishes of Heworth and St. Alban, Heworth, in the diocese of Durham.

7. Amending an earlier Scheme creating the new benefice of Pershore with Pinvin, Wick and Birlingham, in the diocese of Worcester.

8. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of St. John the Baptist, Cudworth, in the diocese of Wakefield, to use as a public burial ground, and vesting the land in the Wakefield Diocesan Board of Finance for that purpose.

9. Uniting the benefices of Nettlebed; Bix with Pishill; and St. Paul, Highmore, in the diocese of Oxford.

10. Uniting the benefices and parishes of All Saints with St. Philip and Holy Trinity, Maidstone; and St. Stephen, Tovil, in the diocese of Canterbury.

11. Appropriating The Paupers Burial Ground, in the parish of Bath Abbey with Saint James, in the diocese of Bath and Wells, for use as a garden for a private dwelling house and vesting the said land in the Bath and Wells Diocesan Board of Finance Ltd. for disposal for such use.

12. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of Lostock Gralam, in the diocese of Chester, to use as a school playground and a second part of the said churchyard to use by the parochial church council of the said parish for any ecclesiastical purpose affecting the said parish.

13. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of Wymering with Widley, in the diocese of Portsmouth, to use by the parochial church council as part of the site of a new church hall.
