The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

- (1) An Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to provide that the slip roads which he proposes to construct at Llanfair-pwllgwyngyll in the County of Gwynedd to connect the Llanfairpwllgwyngyll to Four Crosses Road (B5420) with the route of the Llanfairpwllgwyngyll By-Pass shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation.
- (2) an Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
  - (a) (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
    - (ii) to stop up highways;
    - (iii) to construct new highways;
    - (iv) to stop up private means of access to premises; and

(v) to provide new means of access to premises, all at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll aforesaid; and

(b) to provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Gwynedd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Copies of the Orders and of the relevant plans have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Curran Embankment Depository, Curran Embankment, Cardiff; at the offices of Gwynedd County Council, County Offices, Caernarfon; and Isle of Anglesey Borough Council, Borough Council Offices, Llangefni and the Post Office at Llanfair-pwllgwyngyll, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within 6 weeks from 5th March 1981, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.
