#### SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Surrey (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Surrey propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 which will have the effect of restricting waiting and parking of vehicles by introducing "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions in the following lengths of roads in the County of Surrey:

##### A3014—*The Street, Tongham*

1. West side from the junction with C19 Grange Road northwards towards Oxenden Road for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards)
2. East side from its junction with C19 Poyle Road:
  - (i) northwards towards Oxenden Road for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards)
  - (ii) southwards towards Hog's Back for a distance of 20 metres (22 yards).

##### C19—*Grange Road, Tongham*

1. North side westwards towards the White Hart Inn:
  - (a) from the junction with A3014 The Street for a distance of 49 metres (53 yards)
  - (b) from a point 58 metres (63 yards) west of its junction with The Street for a distance of 7 metres (8 yards)
2. South side from the junction with A3014 The Street westwards towards The White Hart Inn for a distance of 51 metres (56 yards).

##### C19—*Poyle Road, Tongham*

- From the junction with A3014 The Street eastwards towards St. Paul's Church:
- (a) North side for a distance of 62 metres (68 yards)
  - (b) South side for a distance of 58 metres (63 yards)

##### A323 *Aldershot Road, Ash*

- From the Surrey/Hampshire boundary eastwards towards the Caravan Site:
- (a) North side for a distance of 42 metres (46 yards)
  - (b) South side for a distance of 36 metres (39 yards)

##### Reason:

The proposed Order is required to reduce the congestion and attendant hazard created by the parking of vehicles at and on the approaches to the junction of A3014 The Street, Tongham with C19 Grange Road/Poyle Road Tongham and the road bridge at the Surrey/Hampshire boundary A323 Aldershot Road, Ash.

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

*The East Sussex (Road at Bexhill) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council has made an Order under sections 1, 28(1), 31(1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, which has the following effect on various roads in Bexhill:

(a) prohibits waiting at any time in parts of the following roads:

(d) makes a 5 metres length of the north side of Salisbury Road a parking place for one disabled person's vehicle.

Exceptions have been included in the Order (in the case of (a) and (b) above) in respect of disabled persons' vehicles and to permit picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the Order and plans showing the roads may be examined at my office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until 29th April 1981. Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 18th March 1981 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
