LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976

*Anglian Water Authority, Swavesey Internal
Drainage District*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11 (4) and 109 (6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, has now confirmed the Anglian Water Authority (Swavesey Internal Drainage District) Order 1980 (S.I. 1981/398) made on 6th November 1980 to confirm the Scheme submitted to him under section 11 (1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, making provision for:

- (i) the constitution of the Swavesey Internal Drainage District and of the Swavesey Internal Drainage Board; and
 - (ii) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.
- The Scheme affects lands in the Parishes of Longstanton and Swavesey in the District of South Cambridgeshire in the county of Cambridgeshire.

The Scheme may affect the liability to drainage rates of properties in the areas mentioned above.

A copy of the Order may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Anglian Water Authority, Great Ouse House, Clarendon Road, Cambridge CB2 2BL, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 401, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London SW1P 2AE.

By paragraphs 10, 11 and 12 of Schedule 3 to the Land Drainage Act 1976, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with he may, within 6 weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly

made, the court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
