- (iv) between its junction with Welland Street and its junction with Churchill Street.
- (b) Prohibit the driving of vehicles in Welland Street for a distance of 3 metres from a point 32 metres south of Severn Street.
- (c) Prohibit vehicles waiting at any time except for permitted loading in:
  - (i) Avon Street, between Upper Tichborne Street and 10 metres north thereof.

- (d) The present "one-way" traffic flow in Medway Street and the waiting restrictions in Hamilton Street are suspended for the duration of this Order.
