The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto Charles Granville Moray Lloyd-Baker Her Majesty's Royal Licence and Authority that he may bear and use the Armorial Bearings of Lloyd-Baker and that such Armorial Bearings may in like manner be taken and assumed and borne and used by his descendants, the said Armorial Bearings being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms; otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and Decoration be recorded in the said College of Arms.

*Notice of Disclaimer Under Section 355
of the Companies Act 1948*

Whereas:

(1) Pursuant to section 290 of the Companies Act 1948 Storforth Contractors Ltd (hereinafter called "the Company") became dissolved on or about 22nd September 1976.

(2) It is alleged that immediately before such dissolution the property disclaimed by this Notice was vested in the Company and may by virtue of section 354 of the Companies Act 1948 be deemed to have become bona vacantia and to have vested in the Crown.

(3) It is desired to disclaim the Crown's Title (if any) to the property.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Home Department has made an Order under section 12 of the Coroners (Amendment) Act 1926 for the alteration of coroners' districts in the county of Hereford and Worcester.

The Order provides for the division of the county of Hereford and Worcester into 3 coroners' districts which shall be known as the Western coroner's district, the North Eastern coroner's district and the central coroner's district.
