NEW TOWNS ACT 1965

Warrington New Town, Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way, Mill Lane, Winwick, Warrington

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1965, has made an Order extinguishing from the date of the Order the Public Rights of Way over the following route shown coloured red on the map referred to therein:

That part of the former Mill Lane starting from a point marked A on the map at its junction with the new alignment of Mill Lane approximately 75 metres south of Grove Farm and running in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 95 metres to a point marked B on the map at its junction with the new alignment of Enfield Park Road.

The Order is dated 6th April 1981 and a copy of it and of the map referred to in it may be inspected at the offices of the Warrington Development Corporation, New Town House, Buttermarket Street, Warrington, during normal office hours.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
