to the Laws of Arms certain Armorial Bearings which were granted and assigned to The Institute of Builders by Letters Patent under the hands and seals of Garter, Clarenceux and Norroy Kings of Arms dated 28th November 1934; the said Armorial Bearings to be first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms; otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect.
