Rockliffe Road

North side, from its junction with Roman Road for a distance of approximately 40 metres in a westerly direction.

South side, from its junction with Roman Road for a distance of approximately 15 metres in a westerly direction.

Roman Road, west side, from its junction with Rockliffe Road for a distance of approximately 10 metres in a southerly direction. (482)

MOLE VALLEY DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Mole Valley District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Mole Valley District Council proposes to make an Order under sections 31 (1) and 84C (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, section 186 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to revoke the Mole Valley District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1980 and subsequent amending Orders and to re-enact the provisions of those Orders with the following amendments:

- (1) The inclusion in the Schedule to the Order of the new multi-storey car park at Leatherhead.
- (2) With the exception of the multi-storey car park, Leatherhead, and the short-term car parking area at Lower Shott, Bookham (both of which will be subject to a maximum waiting period of 3 hours) the maximum waiting period applying in the short term car parks will be increased from 3 hours to 10 hours.
- (3) At the Reigate Road, Dorking car park long-term (up to 24 hours) parking and the parking of goods vehicles will be permitted only in the southern section of the car park (other than the two rows of parking spaces on the western extremity); the remainder will be available for use as a short-term car park with a maximum waiting period of 10 hours.
- (4) The charges for use of the multi-storey car park, Leatherhead, will be 10p for each hour.
- (5) The short-term parking area at Lower Shott, Bookham will continue to be available for use free of charge.
- (6) In all other short-term car parks the charges will be 10p for up to 1 hour, 20p for up to 2 hours, 30p for up to 3 hours and thereafter 20p for each additional hour, except that in respect of the short-term car parks at Lower Road, Bookham, Grove Road, Ashstead, and the Peace Memorial Hall, Ashstead, the charge for the first hour will be 5p. These will replace the existing charges of 5p for half an hour, 10p for up to 2 hours and 20p for up to 3 hours.
- (7) The charge for long-term car parks will be increased from 30p to 40p for up to 24 hours (10 hours at Church Road, Leatherhead).

SCUNTHORPE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Scunthorpe Borough Council on 5th May 1981 made an Order under sections 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to:

- (1) Revoke
 - (a) The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1972;

(b) The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1973;

(c) The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1975;

(d) The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order No. 1 1975;

(e) The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1976; and

(f) The Borough of Scunthorpe (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1978.

(2) Provide for the introduction of the Pay and Display charging system in the car parks set out in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto.

(3) Impose the following charges in the said car parks between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:

(a) Two hours or less, 10p.

(b) Each additional period of two hours or less, 10p. Exemptions are provided for:

(a) invalid carriages;

(b) vehicles displaying a relevant disabled person's badge;

(c) motor cycles with or without sidecars;

(d) heavy goods vehicles as defined;

(e) vehicles displaying an exemption certificate issued by the Borough Council; and

(f) public service vehicles as defined.

(4) Provide for the issue of season tickets (to be valid in only certain car parks) at the following rates:

Monthly, £5.50.

Three monthly, £15.00.

Yearly, £55.00.

(5) Provide in certain circumstances for a standard charge of £5 to be levied for failure to comply with conditions of the Order.

(6) Govern the proper use and management of the car parks set out in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 18th May 1981, showing the location of the car parks may be seen in the office of the Borough Surveyor and Planning Officer during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may within 6 weeks from the date of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
