Notice is hereby given that Hartlepool Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to revoke the existing waiting restrictions under which you are not allowed to leave your vehicle between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the east side of Murray Street from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Lynnfield Road for a distance of 42 metres in a southerly direction.

HOVE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hove Borough Council (Various Roads) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that Hove Borough Council, as agents for East Sussex County Council, propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

A yellow "boxed area" will be provided in Station Road, Portslade at its junction with Vale Road, Portslade. Subject to a number of usual exceptions which are included in the draft order, vehicles will be prohibited from entering and coming to rest in the boxed area when other stationary vehicles are preventing them from leaving it.

The waiting of vehicles will be prohibited, subject to the usual exceptions:

(a) At all times in parts of the following roads:

Godwin Road
Hangleton Road
Stapley Road
York Avenue

(b) Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in part of Stapley Road.

Appropriate amendments and revocations will be made in respect of existing traffic regulation orders to give effect to the above, and additionally to provide that the prohibition of waiting of vehicles at all times in Wilbury Villas on the east side southwards for a distance of 28 metres from the kerb-line at the north end of Wilbury Villas will no longer apply.

HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Humberside (Glanford Borough) (Various Streets, Winterton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) Order 1981.
