*The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) Regulations 1972**The Gas (Metrication) Regulations 1980*

Notice is hereby given that, in pursuance of Regulation 4 of the Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) Regulations 1972 and Regulation 3 (3) of the Gas (Metrication) Regulations 1980, the calorific value of all natural gas supplied by the British Gas Corporation on or after 1st July 1981 in the areas described by reference to Local Authority Districts as set out in the Schedule will be 37.9 Megajoules per cubic metre (1,016 British Thermal Units per cubic foot). The said areas are delineated by a green line and hatched green on a map signed by the undersigned and kept at the office of the Northern Region at Norgas House, Killingworth, Tyne and Wear where it is open to inspection by any consumer at all reasonable times free of charge.

In the County of Durham

Parts of the Districts of Chester-le-Street, Darlington, Derwentside, Durham, Easington, Sedgfield, Teesdale and Wear Valley.

In the County of Cleveland

Parts of the Districts of Hartlepool, Langbaugh, Middlesbrough and Stockton-on-Tees.

In the County of North Yorkshire

Parts of the Districts of Hambleton, Harrogate and Richmondshire.

In the County of Cumbria

Parts of the Districts of Allerdale, Carlisle, Copeland and Eden.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

County of Avon (Prewett Street Area, City of Bristol) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2), (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- (1) to prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (2) to prohibit any vehicle waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (3) to prohibit any vehicle waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday (inclusive) for longer than one hour in any two hourly period in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
- (4) to institute one way traffic working in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 4 to this notice in a direction specified in relation to that length of road in column 2 of the said Schedule;
- (5) to prohibit any vehicle entering on or proceeding in the length of road specified in Schedule 5 to this notice;
- (6) to consolidate and to revoke the provisions of Orders currently in operation to give effect to the above measures.

Exemptions in the Order are provided with respect to the waiting restrictions for the purposes of boarding or alighting; loading or unloading goods; Post Office services; maintenance of the road; supply of gas, water or electricity; the pursuance of statutory powers or duties; taking in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the road; weddings or funerals and in accordance with the current provisions for disabled persons vehicles.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft Order, which, together with a map and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the under-mentioned offices (sixth floor) during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned within 21 days of the date of this Notice.
