*The West Midlands County Council (Nova Scotia Street, City) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1981*

*Proposed Off-Street Parking Places Order The West Oxfordshire District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Burwell Farm) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that on 25th May 1981, the West Oxfordshire District Council made the above Order under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Local Government Act, 1974, to control the use of the parking place named in the Schedule to this notice, which shows the class of vehicles, the days and time of operation and the maximum period for waiting.

*The Borough of Preston (Traffic Regulation) Various Streets Order (No. 2) 1981*

Notice is hereby given that the Preston Borough Council as agent of the Highway Authority the Lancashire County Council in exercise of its powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, has made on 22nd May 1981 the above-mentioned Order. The Order came into

operation on 27th May 1981 and its effect is to make the following waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road:

*Aqueduct Street.* No waiting at any time on both sides between Inkerman Street and Bold Street.

*Deepdale Mill Street.* No waiting at any time on both sides of Deepdale Mill Street between Castleton Road and the north side of the level crossing.

*Peel Hall Street.* No waiting at any time on both sides of Peel Hall Street from Deepdale Mill Street for a distance of 20 metres westwards.
