If the widow of a naval locally engaged rating who has been granted a pension under the terms of this Order in Council re-marries her pension will cease on the date of her re-marriage.

3. Children

4. An allowance may be made in respect of a motherless child who having attained the age of 18 years is incapable of self-support by reason of infirmity which arose before the normal age limit for pension purposes.

5. Educational Allowance

In addition to an allowance under Clause 3 above an allowance not exceeding £60.00 per annum may be granted for the purpose of the child's education provided:

(a) the child has reached the age of 5 years, but where the child begins school before the age of 5 years an allowance may be granted from the beginning of the school term in the course of which the child attains the age of 5 years;

(b) family circumstances are such as to require it.

6. Parents

If the death of a naval locally engaged rating is accepted as attributable to service his parent or parents may be granted an allowance subject to such conditions as the Defence Council may determine provided that:

(a) he did not leave a widow or eligible child;

(b) the parent or parents are in pecuniary need by reason of having reached the age of not less than 65 years (man) or 60 years (woman).

In determining an award account shall be taken of the extent to which the naval locally engaged rating was supporting his parents at the time of his death, and the extent to which, if he had not died, he would have been likely to continue to support them. The weekly rate shall not exceed:

(a) where there are two parents £0.69

(b) in single parent cases £0.50

The grant shall cease on the re-marriage of the grantee under (b). (2 SI)

NOTICE

The Treasury hereby give notice that in accordance with the powers conferred upon them by the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 c. 13) on or after 6th June 1981:

I. Different rates of interest shall be charged on loans made by the Public Works Loan Commissioners according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

II. The rates of such interest shall be—

Loans to local authorities as defined in paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the said Act.
