

United Kingdom is at 174 Marylebone Road, London NW1 5AT, for construction and use of a 30 inch crude oil pipeline extending between the Brae Platform at latitude 58° 41' 33.4" North and longitude 01° 16' 54.2" East and the Forties FC Platform at latitude 57° 43' 37.6" North and longitude 00° 50' 51.1" East.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Bournemouth (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 14th May 1981 the Bournemouth Borough Council, acting as agent of the Dorset County Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council, made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 5 to the Transport Act 1980.

The Order will come into operation on 1st June 1981.

The Order reproduces those provisions contained in the Borough of Bournemouth (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975 and all those provisions contained in the Borough of Bournemouth (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975 (Variations) (Nos. 1-88) Orders 1975 to 1981.

The usual exceptions will apply to loading and unloading goods, picking up and setting down passengers and certain works.

A copy of the Order showing the restricted roads are available at my office where they may be examined between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 5 to the Transport Act 1980, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as amended or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 14th May 1981, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
