The Greater Manchester County (Twist Lane, Firs Lane and Wigan Road, Leigh) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) (County) Order 1981.

Wigan Road, Leigh, both sides, from Twist Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 35 metres.

Twist Lane, Leigh, both sides, from Wigan Road eastwards to a point 35 metres east of that junction.

- (b) To prohibit waiting at any time and no loading/unloading between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays on:

Twist Lane, Leigh, north side, from a point 25 metres east of Wigan Road for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.

The Greater Manchester County (Doctors Nook Leigh) (Restriction of Waiting) (County) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd June 1981, the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays on:

Doctors Nook, Leigh, from its junction with Union Street to its junction with Market Street.

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, building operations or work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled persons vehicles bearing a disabled persons badge and a parking disc will be allowed to park for a period of up to 2 hours return prohibited within 1 hour.
