The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert part of the public right-of-way shown tion, will be to divert part of the public right-of-way shown coloured pink on the map attached to the Order, which runs in a generally southerly direction commencing at a point in Houghton Road, Houghton Regis (marked A on the map attached to the Order) opposite 8 Townsend Terrace, Houghton Regis, and then in an east-south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 37 metres, then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 249 metres, then in a south-south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 5. The metres of the point marked B distance of approximately 5 metres to the point marked B on the map attached to the Order. The width of the right-of-way is approximately 3 metres. The appropriate Ord-nance Survey sheet showing the existing right-of-way is No. TL 02 SW.
