The Order will come into operation in two stages. The provisions relating to the application for and issue of permits will become effective on 13th July 1981 and the remaining provisions will come into operation on 17th August 1981.

Brentwood District Council (St. James Road and Kings Road) (Temporary Prescribed Route) Order 1981

The effect of the temporary Order will be to prescribe that vehicles travelling in an easterly direction in St. James Road shall, on reaching the junction with Kings Road, make a left turn into Kings Road.

The Order, which will come into effect on 17th August 1981, shall remain in force, (subject to the consent of the Secretary of State) for a period of approximately 6 months until such time as the installation of traffic signals can be undertaken at the junction of Kings Road/St. James Road/King Edward Road.

District of Brentwood (Kings Road and the Parade) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 17th August 1981, will be to prohibit waiting at any time in the undermentioned lengths of road. (The only exemption to the Order is for emergency vehicles and to vehicles in the section of Kings Road between a point 67 metres south of the junction with King Edward Road and The Parade southwards for a distance of 15 metres for so long as is necessary for the vehicle to wait to enable parcels to be delivered to or collected from the adjoining rail station.) Save for the exemption mentioned loading and unloading will also be prohibited in the lengths of road concerned.

The Parade east side from its junction with King

The Parade, east side, from its junction with King Edward Road and Kings Road southwards for a distance of 27 metres.

The Parade, west side, from its junction with King Edward Road and Kings Road southwards for a distance of 13 metres.

Kings Road, east side, from its junction with King Edward Road and The Parade southwards for a distance of 82 metres.

District of Brentwood (The Parade) (Street Parking Places) Order 1981

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 14th September 1981, will be to provide on-street parking facilities in that section of The Parade, on its southern side, from a point 88 metres south of its junction with King Edward Road eastwards for a distance of 72 metres. The Order also prescribes the manner in which vehicles are to be parked and limits waiting to half hour between 7 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 7 p.m.; and to 2 hours between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Mondays to Fridays in each case.

District of Brentwood (The Parade, Brentwood) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 14th September 1981, will be to prohibit the parking of vehicles in the following lengths of roads between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday:

East side and north side, from a point 27 metres south of its junction with King Edward Road southwards and then eastwards for a distance of 143 metres to its junction with Rose Valley.

South side, from a point 82 metres south of its junction with King Edward Road eastwards for a distance of 6 metres.

A copy of each of the Orders together with the appropriate maps showing the roads affected are available at the office of the Secretary of the Council, Council Offices, Ingrave Road, Brentwood, where they may be inspected during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of any of the Orders or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or, on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders you may, within 6 weeks, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
