GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Town of Winchcombe) (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that on 1st July 1981, the Gloucestershire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit and restrict the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of roads and on the sides of roads as specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this notice.

Exemptions to the proposed prohibition and restriction of waiting will permit waiting for the following purposes:

(1) The picking up and setting down of passengers

- (2) The vehicle to be used in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the roads or in connection with services therein or the removal of any obstructions to traffic.
- (3) The vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (4) The delivery or collection of mail by a vehicle in the service of or employed by the Post Office.
- (5) Fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

Exemptions will also apply for disabled persons' vehicles. Any vehicle will also be permitted to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 7th July 1981, together with the relevant map may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Gloucester, and at the Branch Library, Back Lane, Winchcombe, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the ground that any requirements of that Act or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
