The County of South Glamorgan (Improvement to A4050 Port Road) (Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1981

On behalf of the Health Ministers, that is to say the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland, and on behalf of the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, it is hereby declared under section 65(8) of the Medicines Act 1968 that the Amendments to the European Pharmacopoeia set out in the Schedule hereto, which were adopted by the European Pharmacopoeia Commission on 30th June 1981 and published in accordance with the Convention on the Elaboration of a European Pharmacopoeia, are to have effect for the purposes of the said section 65 on 1st October 1981.

SCHEDULE*Supplement to Volume II**Aqua ad Iniectionabilia (Water for Injections)*

Page 33. Modified tests to be applied to Water for Injections after sterilisation. Add the following:

"Chlorides (Vol I, page 107) For containers with a nominal volume of 10 ml or less, 15 ml complies with the limit test for chlorides (0.5 ppm). Prepare the standard using a mixture of 1.5 ml of chloride standard solution (5 ppm Cl) R and 13.5 ml of water."

*Volume III**Acidum Tartaricum (Tartaric Acid)*

Page 137. Specific optical rotation. Replace the text by the following:

"Specific optical rotation (Vol I, page 80) Dissolve 4.00g in water and dilute to 20.0 ml with the same solvent. The specific optical is between +11.9° and +12.7°."

*Supplement to Volume III**Vaccinum Diphthericum Adsorbatum [Diphtheria Vaccine (Adsorbed)]*

Determination of potency. In the ninth line from the foot of page 167 and in the first line of page 169, replace "a series differing by 2.5-fold steps" by "a series differing by not more than 2.5-fold steps".

Caccinum Tetanicum Adsorbatum [Tetanus Vaccine (Adsorbed)]

Determination of potency. In the seventeenth line from the foot of page 176 and in the fifth line from the foot of page 177, replace "a series differing by 2.5-fold steps" by "a series differing by not more than 2.5-fold steps".
