The Bath City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1981

Motor cycles with 2 wheels

Between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on weekdays, 20p.

Between 8 p.m. and 8 a.m. the following day, 15p.

Any period of 24 consecutive hours on weekdays, 35p. On Sundays, Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays between 8 a.m. and 8 a.m. the following day, 15p.

- (c) to provide an opportunity for a motorist who leaves his vehicle in the Great Stanhope Street surface parking place for longer than any period for which he had paid, to avoid the liability to pay an excess daily charge by purchasing additional parking tickets to the value of 50p. before leaving the parking place; and
- (d) not to provide any availability for season ticket vehicles to use the Great Stanhope Street surface parking place.

Apart from the changes outlined above, all the provisions of the existing Order remain unchanged.
