THANET DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Thanet District Council (The Borough of Margate (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulation) Order, Amendment Order (No. 3), 1971) (Partial Revocation) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that the Thanet District Council, in exercise of the powers delegated to it by the Kent County Council, the highway authority made an Order on 28th July 1981, under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974. It will come into operation on 1st August 1981.

The effect of this Order is that The Borough of Margate (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulation) Order, Amendment Order (No. 3), 1971, is revoked insofar as it relates to the side of road specified in the Schedule to this notice but not otherwise. That is to say, you will no longer be restricted from leaving your vehicle on the side of road referred to.

The Thanet District Council (Various Roads, District of Thanet, Kent) (Restricted Roads) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Thanet District Council, in the exercise of Powers delegated to it by the Kent County Council, the highway authority, made an order on 22nd July 1981 under sections 72 (3), 73 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972. It will come into operation on 14th August 1981.

The effect of this Order is that you will not be allowed to drive any motor vehicles on any of the roads or lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour. (The majority of the roads and lengths of road are already subject to a 30 miles per hour limit but are included in the Order as a consolidating measure). All current related Orders are revoked by the Order.
