PASTORAL MEASURE 1968

Notice is hereby given that Her Majesty was pleased on the 23rd September 1981 by Order in Council to confirm the following Schemes made by the Church Commissioners

- 1. Declaring redundant the parish church of All Saints, West Barkwith, in the diocese of Lincoln.
- 2. Altering the names and areas of the parishes of Doulting with East Cranmore, West Cranmore and Downhead; and Leigh-upon-Mendip; and uniting the benefices

- of Shepton Mallet; and Doulting with East Cranmore, West Cranmore and Downhead, in the diocese of Bath and Wells.
- 3. Altering the areas of the parishes of Wroughton and Lydiard Tregoz; and uniting the parishes of Lydiard Millicent and Lydiard Tregoz, in the diocese of Bristol.
- 4. Uniting the parishes of Manningford Bruce; and Manningford Abbots, in the diocese of Salisbury.
- 5. (1) Transferring the parish of Whitminster from the benefice of Frampton-on-Severn with Whitminster to the benefice of Standish with Haresfield and Moreton Valence; (2) altering the names of the said benefices; and (3) effecting transfers of a share of the patronage of the said benefices, in the diocese of Gloucester.
- 6. Uniting the benefices of Morton; and St. Peter, Stonebroom, in the diocese of Derby.
- 7. Uniting the benefices of Rotherfield and St. Mark, Mark Cross, in the diocese of Chichester.
- 8. (1) Transferring the patronage of the benefice of St. Paul, Foleshill;
 (2) altering the name of the benefice and parish of Foleshill; and
- (3) establishing a group ministry for the area of the benefices of St. Laurence, Foleshill; St. Paul, Foleshill; and St. Thomas, Longford, in the diocese of Coventry.
- 9. Holding in plurality the benefices of Dewsall with Callow, Holme Lacy with Dyndor, Little Dewchurch and Aconbury with Ballingham and Bolstone; St. Martin, Hereford; and Upper and Lower Bullinghope with Grafton; in the diocese of Hereford; and establishing a team ministry for the area of the benefice of St. Martin, Hereford and these benefices which continue to be held in plurality with the said benefice. in plurality with the said benefice.
- 10. Appropriating the redundant church of St. Matthias, Upper Tulse Hill, in the diocese of Southwark and the annexed land to use for religious and social purposes by the Gospel Tabernacle Church; and empowering the Diocesan Board of Finance to lease the said building and land for such use.
- 11. Providing for the demolition of the redundant church of Holy Trinity, Carlisle, in the diocese of Carlisle, and appropriating its site as part of the annexed churchyard.
- 12. Providing for the demolition of the redundant church of St. Michael and All Angels, Smethwick, in the diocese
