

## SCHEDULE

(a) *Laurel Road*

- (i) North-western side from a point 55 metres in a north-easterly direction from the northern kerb-line of A468 Caerphilly Road to a point opposite the western kerb-line of Wentworth Close.
- (ii) South-eastern side from a point 50 metres in a north-easterly direction from the northern kerb-line of A468 Caerphilly Road to the western kerb-line of Wentworth Close.

(b) *Grosvenor Road*

- (i) Western side from the north-western kerb-line of Laurel Road for a distance of 20 metres.
- (ii) South-eastern side from the north-western kerb-line of Laurel road for a distance of 70 metres.

(c) *Wentworth Close*, western side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Laurel Road for a distance of 15 metres.

## SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The South Yorkshire County Council (Barnsley) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1981 (Amendment No. ) Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to amend South Yorkshire County Council (Barnsley) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1981 by amending the Parking Places (Residents only) parking between 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. in Longman Road and Caxton Street, Barnsley, from the existing Mondays to Saturdays to Mondays to Fridays inclusive. N.B.: The parts of road authorised to be used as street parking places, the positions in which vehicles may wait, and the classes of vehicles will remain unaltered.

It is further proposed to amend the Restriction of Waiting by vehicles in Doncaster Road, Barnsley, in the Barnsley Metropolitan District by adding the following items:

- (i) *Waiting prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive.*

*Doncaster Road*, north-east side, from a point commencing at the termination of Doncaster Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 38.5 metres.

- (ii) *Length of road where waiting is prohibited on any day to 1 hour return prohibited within 3 hours.*

*Doncaster Road*

(i) South-west side, from a point 10 metres northwest of the north-western kerb-line of Quarry Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 13 metres and

(ii) from a point 47 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Quarry Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 23 metres.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicles are also included in the Order.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a map showing the restricted road and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of: (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley; and (ii) Central Library, Shambles Street, Barnsley.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 27th October 1981.

Notice is hereby given that on 17th September 1981, Amber Valley District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath Heanor No. 12, from the stile near to Berle Avenue, Heanor, in a south westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres or thereabouts and to provide a diverted path to join the existing path.
