GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Gwynedd (Various Streets, Caernarfon) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Gwynedd County Council on 16th October 1981 made an Order under section 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect on 2nd November 1981 the present one-way systems on Chapel Street, Segontium Terrace, New Street, Garnon Street, Little Chapel Street, Lower New Street and Lower Garnon Street will be reversed and Pool Street will become a one-way street allowing traffic to proceed in an easterly direction only from Castle Square to its junction with the new inner relief road near the Eagles Hotel.

Moreover, certain restrictions will be lifted on Chapel Street, Segontium Terrace, New Street, Garnon Street, Crown Street and Caernarfon to Caethro Road and you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle:

- (i) at any time on certain sides of Chapel Street, Segontium Terrace, Little Chapel Street, Lower New Street, Lower Garnon Street, Garnon Street, Crown Street and Constantine Road; and
- (ii) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on certain sides of Chapel Street; and
- (iii) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. for a longer period than 30 minutes return prohibited for 2 hours on a certain side of Segontium Terrace.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, taking in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage, and where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of the roads, the supply of gas, electricity or water and the exercise of local authority statutory powers and duties, and in certain circumstances where the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

Full details are in the Order which, together with a map showing the restricted areas, may be examined at the County Offices, Shirehall Street, Caernarfon, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 16th October 1981, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

HARTLEPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hartlepool Borough Council (Archer Street, Exeter Street and Back Tower Street) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that on 19th October 1981 Hartlepool Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974) made the above-named Order the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays and Saturdays inclusive in:

Archer Street, on the north side, from its junction with Tower Street for a distance of 25 metres in an easterly direction.

Exeter Street

On the north side, from its junction with Tower Street for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction.

On the south side, from its junction with Tower Street for a distance of 32 metres in an easterly direction.

Back Tower Street

On the east side, from its junction with Exeter Street for a distance of 67 metres in a northerly direction.

On the west side, from its junction with Exeter Street for a distance of 67 metres in a northerly direction.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas electricity and water and for disabled persons.

A copy of the Order will come into operation on 26th October 1981 and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday at the Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 19th October 1981 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
