

## HEREFORD &amp; WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

*The County of Hereford and Worcester (Elgn Street A438, Hereford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd October 1981 the County Council of Hereford and Worcester made an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to:

- (i) prohibit waiting at any time on any day on the sides of lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (ii) prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the sides of length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice;
- (iii) prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the side of length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice;
  - (a) for a period exceeding 1 hour; or
  - (b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on that side of length of road.

The Order will come into operation on 30th October 1981.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act of 1967 or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this notice), make application for the purpose to the High Court.

## KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Kent County Council (Route B2067 and Otterpool Lane, Lympne) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Revocation) Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd October 1981, the Kent County Council made an Order under section 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to revoke the Waiting Restrictions on the B2067-Hythe-Tenterden Road and Otterpool Lane, Lympne.

## KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Kent County Council (Restricted Roads) (Various Roads, Horsmonden) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd October 1981 the Kent County Council made an Order under sections 72, 73, and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1967, as

amended, the effect of which is to impose a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on the following lengths of road at at Horsmonden:

- (a) *Furnace Lane*, from its junction with Orchard Close, north-westwards for 300 metres to the eastern boundary of No. 1 Heathfield Cottages.
- (b) *Gibbet Lane*, from its northern junction with Furnace Lane eastwards and south-eastwards for 230 metres.
- (c) *Goudhurst Road*, from 2 metres west of the western boundary of "Wendholme" eastwards for 290 metres east of No. 6 Station Cottages.
- (d) *Lamberhurst Road (B2162)* from the northern boundary of "Pen Hall" south-westwards for 210 metres to 14 metres south of No. 8 Springfield Cottages.
- (e) *Maidstone Road (B2162)* from Back Lane at Horsmonden County Primary School north-eastwards for 335 metres to 50 metres north of the entrance to the Sports Ground.

*Lancashire County Council (Grimshaw Street Railway Bridge) (Darwen, Blackburn Borough) (Weight Restriction) Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that the Lancashire County Council propose to make this Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle the gross maximum weight of which exceeds 8 tonnes from proceeding over Grimshaw Street Railway Bridge, Darwen, Blackburn Borough.

The alternative route for traffic affected by this proposal will be via Grimshaw Street (unclassified); Bolton Road (Principal Road A666), Watery Lane and Sough Road (Class III Road, C615-10).

## LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Leicestershire (New Road, Peggs Green Parishes of Coleorton and Swannington) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles over Three Tons) Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3), (3AA) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle, the unladen weight of which exceeds three tons from proceeding along any part of New Road, Peggs Green, in the parishes of Coleorton and Swannington.

The Order will contain exemptions for the purposes of:

- (a) conveying goods to or from premises;
- (b) agriculture in connection with land adjoining the road;
- (c) building or demolition operations;
