COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Colchester Borough (Catchpool Road, Jarmin Road, Etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that the Colchester Borough Council, as Agents for the Essex County Council, propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will prohibit waiting between the hours of 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. from Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive, on the side or in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.
