

46. Providing for the care and maintenance of the redundant church of St. John the Baptist, Inglesham, in the diocese of Bristol, by the Redundant Churches Fund.

47. Providing for the Redundant Churches Fund to be responsible for the care and maintenance of the old church of All Saints, Nuneham Courtenay, in the diocese of Oxford.

48. Providing for the demolition of the redundant church of St. James, Akeley, in the diocese of Oxford, and for appropriating its site to use as part of the annexed burial ground.

49. Appropriating the redundant church of St. Michael and All Angels, Derby, in the diocese of Derby, and part of the annexed land, to use as offices; and empowering the Diocesan Board of Finance to lease the said building and land for such use. (6 SI)
