Copy for the edition dated 31st December should be received by 10.30 a.m. on Thursday, 24th December.

The London Gazette Office will also be closed on Friday, 1st January 1982. There will be no edition published on that day. Copy for the edition dated 4th January 1982 should be received in the London Gazette Office by 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 30th December and by 10.30 a.m. on Thursday, 31st December for the edition dated 5th January 1982.

The co-operation of advertisers is sought to keep the number of notices in the issues for 29th, 30th and 31st December to a minimum by restricting insertions to only those notices which must be published on those days.
