The London Gazette Office will be closed from midday on Thursday, 24th December until 8.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 30th December. The London Gazette will not be published on Friday and Monday, 25th and 28th December, but publication will be resumed on Tuesday, 29th December. Copy for the edition dated 24th December should be received in the London Gazette Office by 10.30 a.m. on Tuesday, 22nd December and by 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 23rd December for the editions dated 29th and 30th December. Copy for the edition dated 31st December should be received by 10.30 a.m. on Thursday, 24th December.

The London Gazette Office will also be closed on Friday, 1st January 1982. There will be no edition published on that day. Copy for the edition dated 4th January 1982 should be received in the London Gazette Office by 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 30th December and by 10.30 a.m. on Thursday, 31st December for the edition dated 5th January 1982.

The co-operation of advertisers is sought to keep the number of notices in the issues for 29th, 30th and 31st December to a minimum by restricting insertions to only those notices which must be published on those days. Whilst every endeavour will be made to ensure that publication is in accordance with advertisers' requirements, the Crown accepts no responsibility for loss or damage howsoever arising from a failure to meet those requirements.

TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

- 1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Registrar's Office (Bank Buildings) at the Bank of England on Thursday 24th December 1981 at 11 a.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.
- 2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Tuesday 29th December 1981 to Thursday 31st December 1981 inclusive and will be due 91 days after date.
- 3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.
- 4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of one new halfpenny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.
