ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1967

The Trunk Road (Pwilglas Village, Clwyd) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 74 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the proposed Order will be that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice will become subject to a speed limit of 40 miles per hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at Glyndwr District Council Offices, Council Offices, Ruthin, Clwyd.
