DERBY CITY COUNCIL

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967

Derby City Council (Hartington Street) (No Waiting) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that Derby City Council pursuant to an arrangement made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Derbyshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, propose to make an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at all times on the following lengths of Hartington Street:

- (i) on the south-east side, between its junctions with Normanton Road and Osmaston Road; and
- (ii) on the north-west side, for a distance of 15 metres from its junctions with Normanton Road and Osmaston Road.

Full details of the proposals including exemptions are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 19th January 1982.

TAMWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967

The Borough of Tamworth (Corporation Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 18th December 1981 the Borough Council of Tamworth pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Stafford in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 made the above stated Order.

The effect of the Order is that no person will be allowed to leave a vehicle on the lengths of sides of roads specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will permit the waiting of invalid carriages and disabled persons' vehicles and will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down of passengers, vehicles used in connection with the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity, water and telegraph lines and in pursuance of statutory duties, building operations and the loading and unloading of goods.

The Order will come into operation on 18th December 1981.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the restricted roads may be examined at the Municipal Offices, Marmion House, Lichfield Street, Tamworth between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 18th December 1981 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Prohibition of waiting 24 hours a day 7 days a week on the following highway:

Corporation Street—West Side from a point 4.5 metres north of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 2.5 metres in a northerly direction; from a point 27 metres north of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly
