RUSHMOOR BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Rushmoor (Station Road, Farnborough) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Rushmoor Borough Council, acting as agents for and on behalf of the County Council of Hampshire, as Highways Authority, have made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be (a) to prohibit waiting at any time on any day in the lengths of roads described in Schedule 1 below and (b) prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the length of road described in Schedule 2 below.
