NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The Cherwell District Council (Banbury Footpath
No. 37) Diversion Order (No. 6) 1981*

Notice is hereby given that on 8th January 1982, the the Cherwell District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public path known as Banbury Footpath No. 37 from its present route through the entrance to Wykham Mill from Bloxham Road at point Grid Ref. 437 376 in a generally west-north-westerly direction past the Mill Buildings and weybridge thence in a north-westerly direction to the silo and westerly for 38 metres to the fence and then north to join the farm track at Grid Ref. SP 435 376 to a new route from Grid Ref. SP 437 376 through the kissing gate on the northern side of the entrance to Wykham Mill in a north-north-westerly direction for 48 metres to the fence at the north-east corner of the mill buildings and then westwards following the perimeter fence for 149 metres to the western end of Wykham Mill to rejoin the existing footpath in the north-west corner of the perimeter fence at Grid Ref. SP 435 376.
